- BSACP represents UK clinicians working in abortion care, providing a supportive community to promote best practice.

- To support holistic education on abortion for all health professionals and facilitate training for abortion care providers.
- To raise standards and promote excellence in abortion care.
- To collaborate with a range of non-governmental and governmental organisations with similar aims and values, liaising with recognised experts and policymakers in the field.
- To facilitate a culture of destigmatisation for those who work in abortion care.
- To provide expertise in taking forward a progressive policy agenda.
- To champion patient-centred care.
- To facilitate health services research in abortion care.

- Authoritative: working from the evidence.
- Critical: using a questioning and analytical approach.
- Ambitious: always aiming to improve abortion care.
- Holistic: working in an interdisciplinary way.
