- Ensure that all content is up-to-date, evidence-based, and suitable for training purposes.
- Deliverables includes development of a modular curriculum that can be adapted to a range of training requests.
- > Complete the review process within the specified timeline.
- Write and finalise the slides, associated course materials and curricula.

Requirements

- Demonstrable expertise in medical research, particularly within the field of abortion care and SRH.
- Demonstrable experience in education and developing educational material.
- Strong understanding of MVA procedures and related training requirements.



- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively with the BSACP team.

Budget

The budget allocated for this project is £2,400. BSACP is open to individuals or teams of two or more collaborating on this project.
